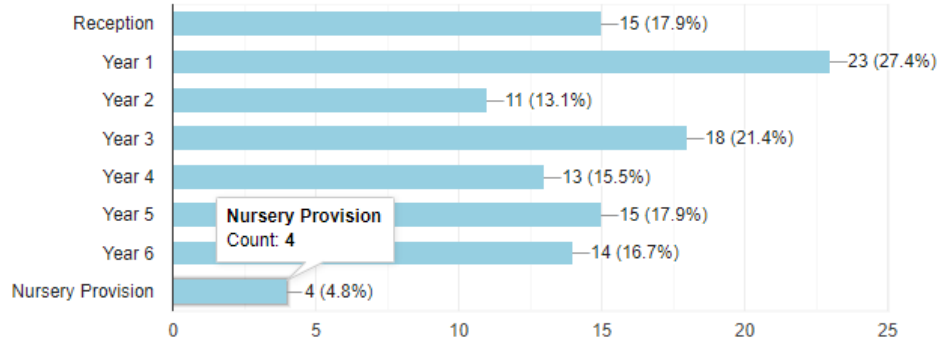

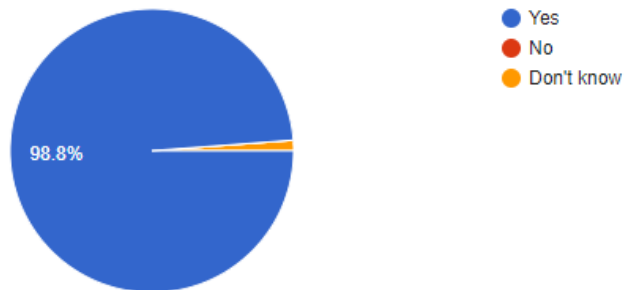


1) Is your child happy at Bardfield Academy?

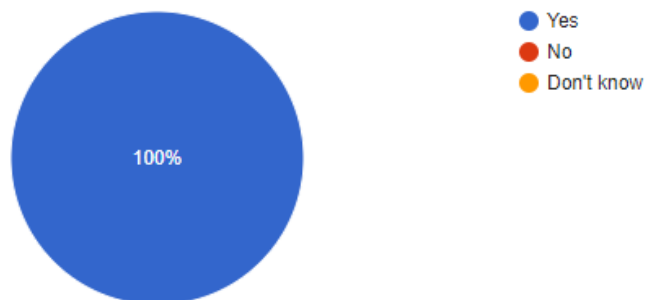


2) Does your child feel safe at Bardfield Academy?

4) Do you feel that your child makes good progress at Bardfield Academy?

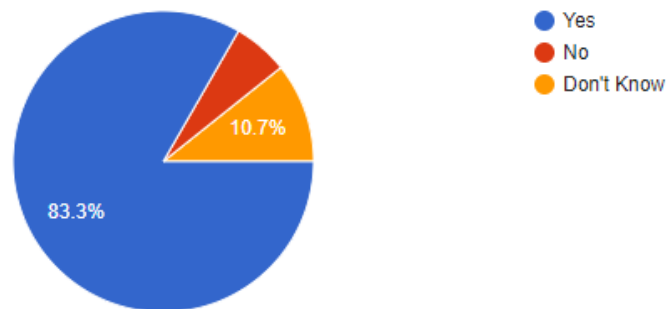
**96% answered yes**

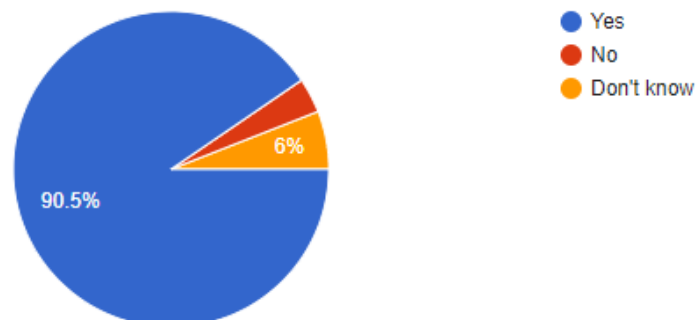


6) Do you feel staff have high expectations regarding behaviour at Bardfield Academy?

7) Do you feel that the school deals decisively with bullying and other incidents?

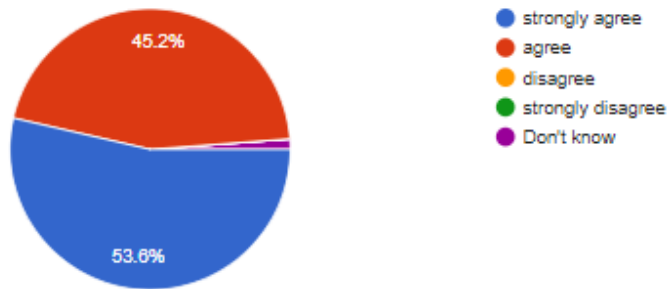
**38% said don't know (either because new to school or not had experience of bullying)**

Do you feel that the school is well led and managed?

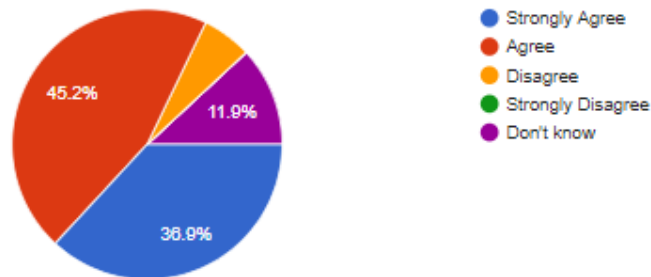

During the lockdown period (March - June) Bardfield Academy provided work suited to your child's/children's age and ability.

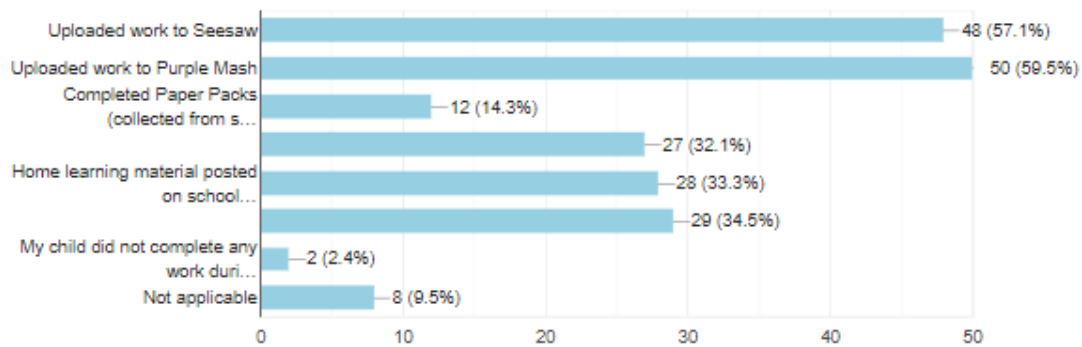

How did your child access work provided over the lockdown period? (select all applicable)

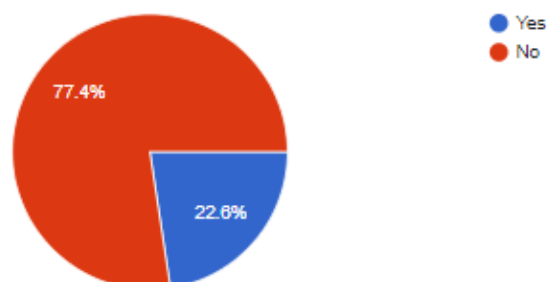

Did access to technology or wifi prevent your child from accessing work set by school over the lockdown period?



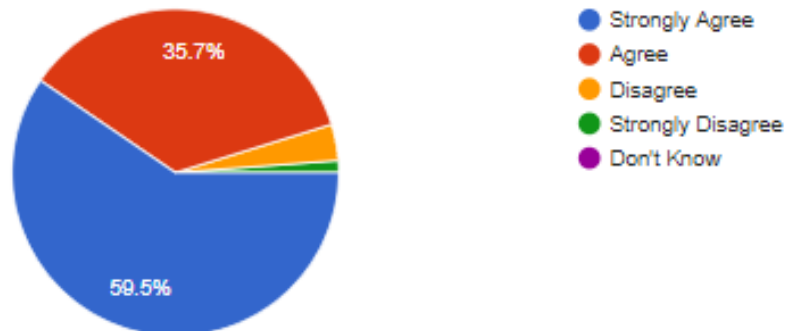

During the lockdown period (March - June) Bardfield Academy kept me informed of changes and updates. Plans were clearly communicated.

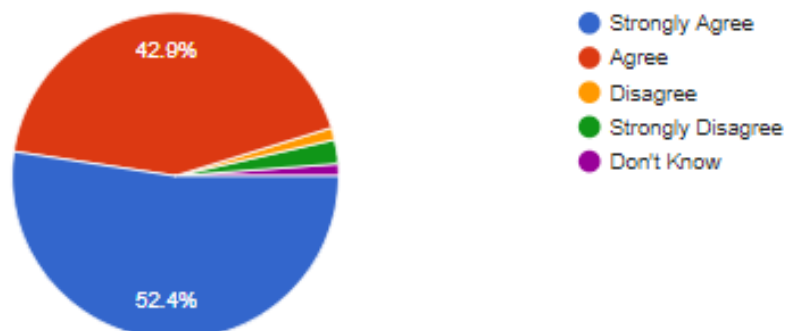
