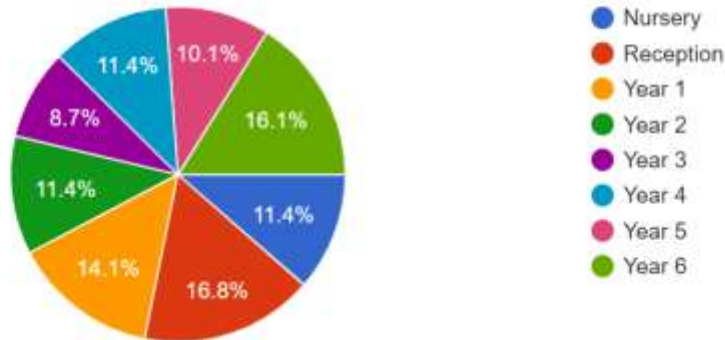




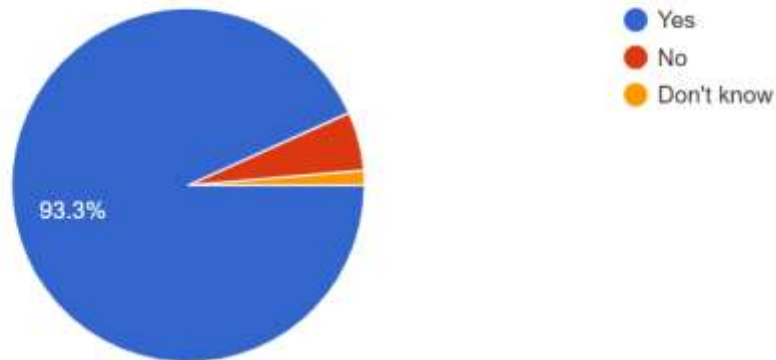
Which year group is your child in?

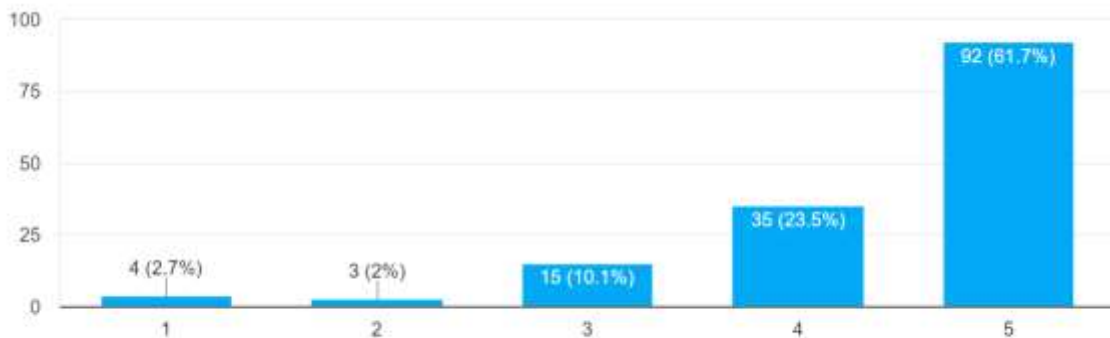

How much do you think your child enjoys school?



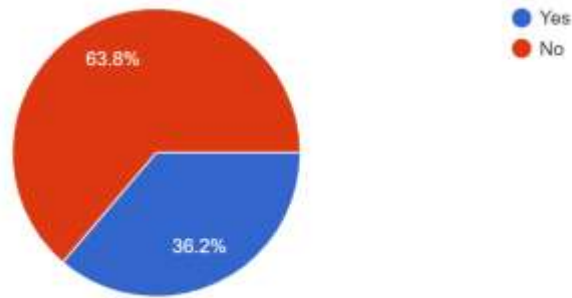

95% selected 3/4/5 for how much their child enjoys school, 5% chose 1/2

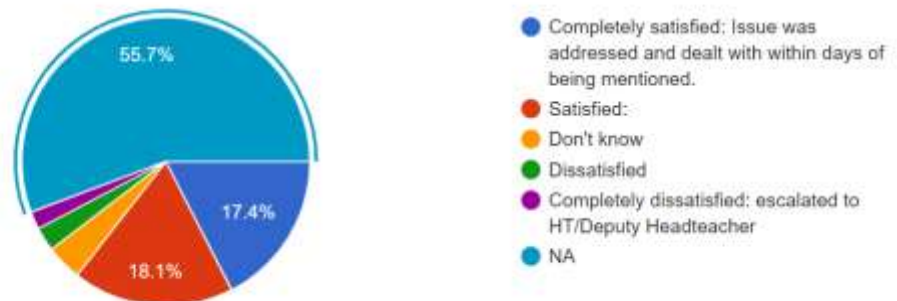
Have you had any concerns that have required you to talk to your child's class teacher?

If you answered yes above, how satisfied were you with how it was addressed?

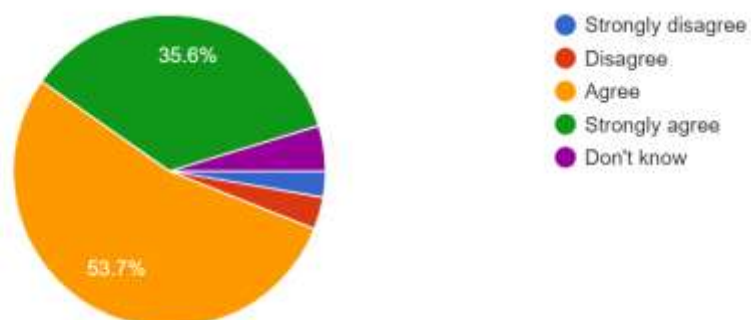

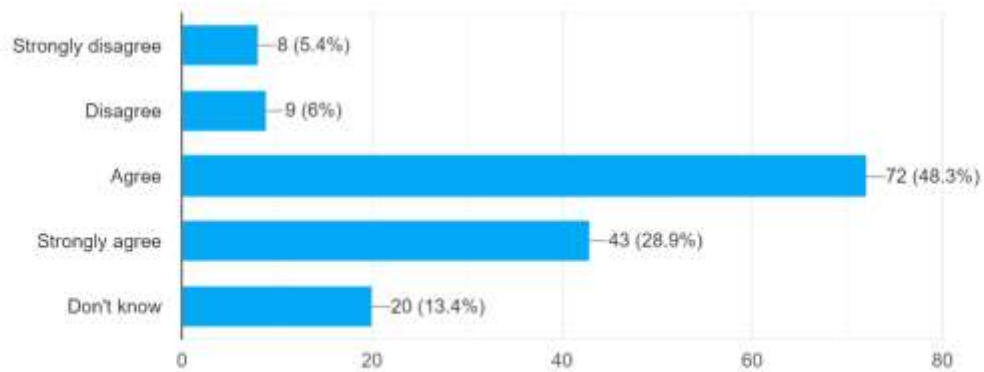

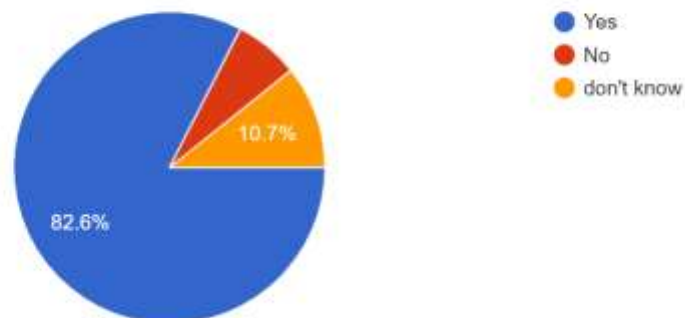

Do you think the school is well led, by the leadership team?

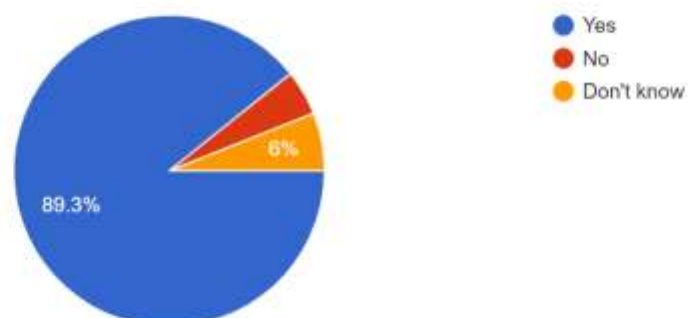

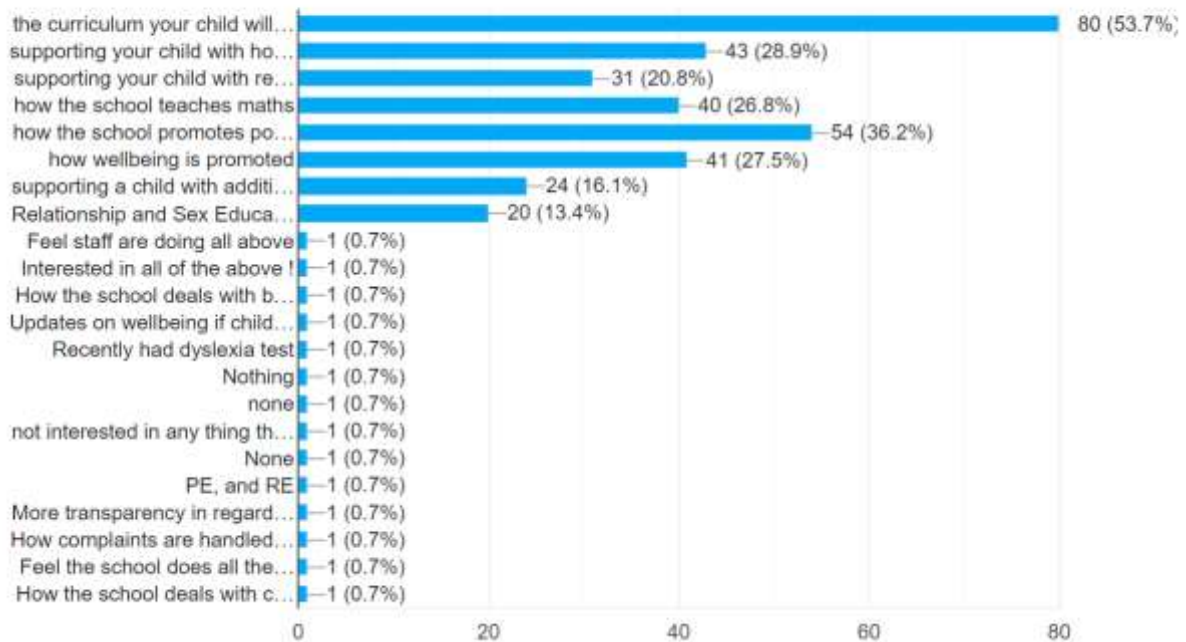


89% of parents feel their child is making good progress, 6% do not know and 5% do not think their child is making good progress.

The majority of parents want to know about the curriculum their child covers. (54%) **(PRIORITY IDENTIFIED)**

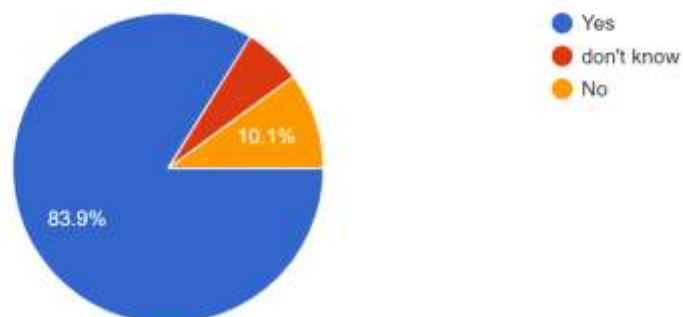
How the school promotes positive behaviour (36%) **(PRIORITY IDENTIFIED)**
